

Stewart Walker is sole proprietor of photogrammetry4u llc in San Diego, California, USA, providing marketing and business development services in photogrammetry, lidar and mapping. He is managing editor of *LIDAR Magazine*. He holds MA, MScE and PhD degrees in geography and geomatics from the universities of Glasgow, New Brunswick and Bristol, and an MBA from Heriot-Watt. He is an ASPRS-certified photogrammetrist. He is a Fellow of the American Society for Photogrammetry and Remote Sensing (ASPRS), the British Cartographic Society, the Royal Geographical Society, the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors, and the Remote Sensing and Photogrammetry Society. After an academic career at the University of East London, Stewart transitioned to the private sector in 1987, working in sales, product management, marketing and business development for Leica Geosystems and its predecessor companies in England, Switzerland and USA. He joined BAE Systems in 2004 and retired in 2017 as director, product initiatives for its Geospatial eXploitation Products business in San Diego.

Stewart served as honorary secretary of the Photogrammetric Society in the 1980s and was secretary of ISPRS Commission IV from 1984 to 1988. He has been Chair of The ISPRS Foundation since 2016. He has served ASPRS in various capacities at regional and national levels, including president for the year 2014-15 and treasurer since 2017.

Stewart served as an industrial advisor to the University of Newcastle upon Tyne from 2006 to 2013 and is currently on adjunct faculty at San Diego State University.
