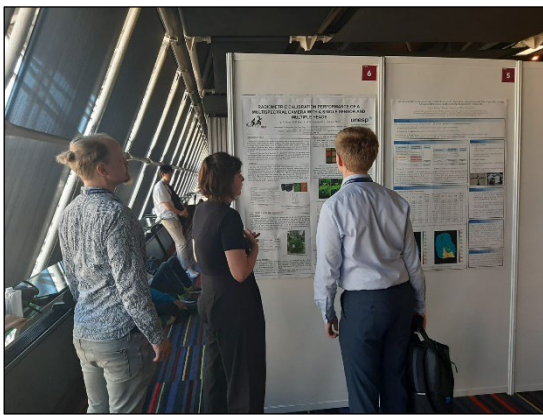


XXIV ISPRS Congress 2022 – Nice, France
