
ISPRS Homepage Annual Report 2010


Since more than 15 years (1995) the ISPRS website (http://www.isprs.org/) is online, is nowadays one of the most important components of ISPRS communications, providing up-to-date information about the society, its events and publications and linking its various activities.

In the last 2 years we can recognize the trend, that the number of visited webpages per month increases.



In December 2010 there were about 3000 html/aspx pages of information available on the ISPRS website and more than 20000 PDF files, most of them in the ISPRS Archives. In total the ISPRS website needs at the moment 30 GB.

In the last time more and more wide screens were coming up as displays for desktop and notebook computers. Using web browsers on these computers in full screen mode has made it difficult to read the text lines of our pages. That was the reason for changing the layout with variable width to a one with fixed width (1000 pixels).



The storage of the ISPRS Archives has been reorganized, so that all papers are stored under http://www.isprs.org/procee-dings/.., which give us now the possibility to search within the archives (see http://www.isprs.org/publications/archives-search.aspx).

The ISPRS mailing list has more than 1000 participants: once a month the latest news inside the website are communicated as well as new events, links and job opportunities.
