

B-2 GUIDING PRINCIPLES FOR THE JOINT BOARD OF REMOTE SENSING ACTIVITIES (JOBRESA)

1. The objective of the Joint Board of Remote Sensing Activities is to coordinate international meetings on remote sensing and to exchange information on the activities of remote sensing institutions.
2. Members of the Joint Board of Remote Sensing Activities may be :
 - a . International societies with an interest in remote sensing
 - b . Regional associations of remote sensing
3. Associate members of the Joint Board of Remote Sensing Activities may be :
 - c . Aerospace agencies or remote sensing centres of international or regional composition
 - d . National aerospace agencies or national remote sensing centres
 - e . Private corporations responsible for dissemination of remote sensing data
 - f . Other organizations involved in international remote sensing

6. Members and associate members may send one designated representative to an annual Joint Board Meeting. The Time and place of the meeting is agreed upon at each previous meeting.
7. The representatives of the Joint Board will decide in simple majority of those present on :
 - admission of new members and new associate members
 - election of a chairman, a secretary and a treasurer for the period until the next meeting
 - Financial contributions of members and associate members
8. The communication language shall be English.
9. The Joint Board subscribes to the policy of ICSU with regard to political, religious and other forms of non-discrimination.
