B-2 GUIDING PRINCIPLES FOR THE JOINT BOARD OF REMOTE SENSING ACTIVITIES (JOBRESA)

- 1. The objective of the Joint Board of Remote Sensing Activities is to coordinate international meetings on remote sensing and to exchange information on the activities of remote sensing institutions.
- Members of the Joint Board of Remote Sensing Activities may be :
 - a. International societies with an interest in remote sensing
 - b. Regional associations of remote sensing
- 3. Associate members of the Joint Board of Remote Sensing Activities may be:
 - c. Aerospace agencies or remote sensing centres of international or regional composition
 - d. National aerospace agencies or national remote sensing centres
 - e. Private corporations responsible for dissemination of remote sensing data
 - f. Other organizations involved in internatinoal remote sensing
