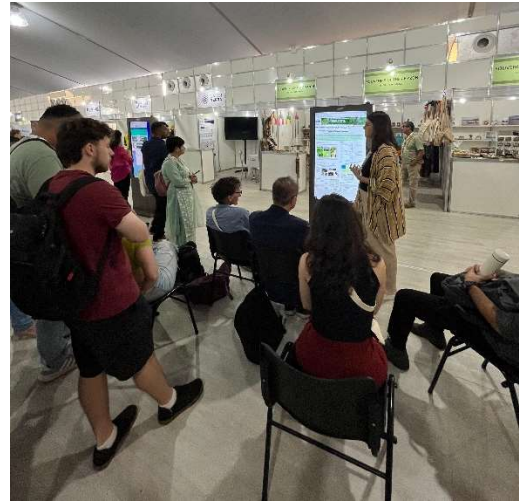


ISPRS Technical Commission III Mid-term Symposium on Remote Sensing – Belém, Brazil
